PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 22, 2009, A SEVERE WINTER STORM

SYSTEM MOVED ACROSS PORTIONS OF IOWA; AND

WHEREAS, THIS STORM SYSTEM SPAWNED FREEZING RAIN, HEAVY SNOW

AND BLIZZARD CONDITIONS, CAUSING DAMAGES AND RELATED

IMPACTS TO PRIVATE AND PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE; AND

WHEREAS, LOCAL OFFICIALS IMPACTED BY THE SEVERE WEATHER NEED

ASSISTANCE WITH EMERGENCY SNOW REMOVAL FROM COUNTY

ROADS; AND

WHEREAS, STATE ASSISTANCE WILL BE NEEDED TO MINIMIZE THE HARDSHIP

AND RECOVER FROM THE IMPACTS OF THIS STORM:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHESTER J. CULVER, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF IOWA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM A STATE OF DISASTER EMERGENCY FOR THE FOLLOWING COUNTIES: HARRISON, POTTAWATTAMIE, SHELBY, FOR THE AFOREMENTIONED REASONS. THIS PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY AUTHORIZES LOCAL AND STATE GOVERNMENT TO RENDER GOODS AND SUFFICIENT AID TO ASSIST THOSE AREAS IN THIS TIME OF NEED.



IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I HAVE HEREUNTO SUBSCRIBED MY NAME AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF IOWA TO BE AFFIXED. DONE AT DES MOINES THIS 29TH DAY OF DECEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD TWO THOUSAND NINE.
