PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, On Saturday, April 9, 2011 and continuing, a severe weather system moved

across portions of Iowa; and

WHEREAS, this storm system spawned severe weather to include tornadoes, wind, hail

and severe thunderstorms causing serious damages and impacts to private and public property, including residences, businesses and infrastructure;

local officials and residents impacted by this severe weather need WHEREAS,

assistance to deal with the impacts of these storms; and

WHEREAS, surveys and reports forwarded by local officials in Buena Vista, Monona,

Pocahontas and Sac counties indicate that state assistance will be needed

to respond to and recover from the effects of these storms.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Terry E. Branstad, Governor of the State of Iowa, do hereby proclaim a state of disaster emergency for Buena Vista, Monona, Pocahontas and Sac counties in the State of Iowa, for the aforementioned reasons. This proclamation of disaster emergency authorizes the implementation of the state individual assistance grant program to assist eligible residents and minimize their hardship.
